When deciding on a hoof supplement it is important to look at the ingredients. Our supplement is formulated to contain Biotin, Zinc, Amino acids (including methionine), Calcium and MSM. These are all the essential ingredients to provide support for every layer within the hoof wall. What does the supplement achieve?

- Provides the building block to make keratin (main protein of hoof)
- Maintains hoof wall integrity
- Rich in sulphur to strengthen the keratin in the hoof



Preventing Sand Colic

Stoven Hall Equine Sand Supplement

Our sand supplement contain psyllium. Psyllium prevents sand building up in the gastrointestinal tract by encouraging sand particles to pass out in the droppings.

If sand does build up, it can irritate the lining of the guts and even cause a blockage (impaction colic). Our sand supplement should be fed for 7 days each month to help prevent sand colic.

Even if your pasture soil is not sandy (eg. clay) in certain conditions sand can be washed to the surface and cause problems for horses.



Keeping things in balance

Stoven Hall Vitamin & Mineral Supplement

There are many balancers on the market. You have to be careful as some contain high levels of sugars. Our supplement is extremely low sugar so you do not have to worry about inducing sugar-related diseases, for example laminitis. This supplement contains 22 nutritional ingredients including vitamin A, D, E and C. These vitamins and minerals form essential parts of your horses diet. A balancer is especially important if the diet is restricted for any reason, for example your horse is on box rest.



Stoven Hall Equine Glucosamine

Feeding Glucosamine HCl 99% pure is a great way of looking after your horse's cartilage, joint fluid, tendons and ligaments. Glucosamine provides your horse with the building blocks for joint fluid to give the joint the best environment for the joint to function. Research shows that supplementing with glucosamine can help joints function better for longer and limit aging changes. It can also help in repair as it can stimulate cartilage regeneration.

Glucosamine HCl 99% pure is the most stable and bioavailable on the market.

Other forms include glucosamine sulphate and n-acetyl-glucosamine



Stoven Hall Equine Premium Joint Supplement

Our premium joint supplement contains Chondroitin, and MSM as well as the Glucosamine HCl. Chondroitin forms the essential shock absorbing component in the cartilage of the joints. Looking after cartilage is essential to maintain the smooth function of a joint and if the cartilage is damaged it can cause significant pain. MSM (methylsulfonylmethane) supplies sulphur to the body to provide the basis to make connective tissue and support the joints.
